Our sustainable products.

We are a supplier of timber products for commercial and residential projects. Our timberframes are made from (both) renewable and sustainable sources. Timber housing design also offers substantial environmental benefits due to its high thermal performance and overall positive environmental features.

Our sustainable approach.

Through our continuous and positive environmental approach we ensure all our business processes, build procedures and product developments are carried out with a sustainable approach in mind.

Our sustainable objectives.

We have set out our objectives to qualify our environmental commitments.

This is how we take responsibility and contribute to protecting our planet. . .

- We are Chain of Custody PEFC registered meaning sustainable purchasing of materials.
- We have developed eco^{tf} to promote off site manufacturing to achieve energy efficient wall, floor and roof panel systems.
- We have invested in a wood fuelled heating system in lieu of a gasoil fired heating system with cost savings of 75% on previous heating bills.
- We use wood waste from the manufacturing process to heat our factory.
- We recycle all waste paper in our work place.
- We have reviewed all our stationery supplies and source from one place to minimise waste.
- We promote a 'print only when required' ethos internally and on our external emails.
- We have implemented a 'switch off' policy in our work places through the use of the recommended Carbon Trust campaign.
- We are developing an 'employee awareness and participation scheme' to be implemented across the business.
- We carry out an environmental evaluation of our supply chain on all products not just our timber products.
- We have developed a 'plasterboard waste collection service' in conjunction with our supply partners.
- We are actively working towards ISO 14001 standard.
- We have set up 'Green Fleet Review' - a working party across our group to help reduce omissions on company cars and promote car sharing, including non-company vehicles.
